

### **OPERATION**

- 1. Plug compressor into grounded electrical socket.
- 2. Attach air hose to compressor and airbrush.
- 3. Press power button. PLEASE NOTE: The compressor is designed for intermittent use. REQUIRES a 15 minute cool down period after 30 minutes of operation. Overuse will cause compressor to malfunction.
- 4. Air pressure can be adjusted through your airbrush. Compressor runs at constant 2 bar.
- 5. Press power switch again to turn off. Always release air pressure from airbrush before restart-ing compressor.

#### TROUBLSHOOTING

#### COMPRESSOR TURNS ON BUT DOES NOT RELEASE AIR

In rare occasions it is possible that the internal air hose can become disconnected. Unplug the compressor from power source and disconnect airbrush. Turn compressor over and remove 4 screws on bottom of unit. Locate the internal air hose and reattach to the side air outlet. Replace the screws securely and follow normal operation instructions.

#### **POWERING OFF DURING USE**

The compressor is equipped with a thermal switch that safeguards the inner components by ceasing power if it becomes overheated or detects insufficient voltage.

Disconnect the compressor from the power outlet for approximately 15-30 minutes before attempting use again.



#### **WARNINGS**


- Read all safety warnings and instructions. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Do not open, disassemble, or attempt to modify. If service is needed take the compressor to a qualified technician for repairs.
- Do not use near or in water, with wet hands or bare feet.
- Use only in a well ventilated area. Keep away from explosive or flammables gases.
- Never leave unattended while in use.
- Do not use with siphon-feed airbrushes.
- Do not touch compressor during or soon after use as it will be hot.
- Unplug from power source when not in use


